President's Message

It is hard to believe that we are sunsetting the year 2024 and that 2025 is so quickly approaching. As fall comes to an end and winter is on the horizon we have been working to finish critical projects which increasingly becomes a challenge with the short days and cooler weather. The cold weather doesn't bother me, but adding some wind and rain certainly puts a damper on outdoor activities.

If we believe the long-range forecasters, our winter in Kentucky should be warmer but wetter than usual, the warmer part I like but the wetter part not so much. Wet conditions always pose a challenge during hay feeding season especially in our area since we tend to get cold enough at night to freeze the ground and then warm enough during the day to thaw. The frequent freeze-thaw cycle in addition to rain and or snow creates sloppy conditions. A few years ago I began using a hay unroller that tows behind a side by side for the bulk of my winter feeding which greatly reduces the impact on our feeding area. This certainly would not work for everyone and there is some hay waste using this feeding process but it is the best method of winter feeding for our operation. I'm thankful for a good stockpile of hay and hopeful that green grass returns in early spring.

As I read articles and listen to webinars, many industry experts believe that we could see an expansion in cattle numbers in the near future. However, producers are still feeling the pinch of rising input costs even with cattle prices at near record highs. One group that continues to feel the impact of the current economics of our industry is the small producer. The average cow herd size is 47 head which means that smaller producers make up a big part of the US beef industry. However, this group has been shrinking as reported by recent census data as the result of age, drought,

cost of production, land prices, and overall profitability and return on investment. It would seem that in order to move the industry forward a more favorable environment for smaller producers will be necessary to make the cattle industry more appealing.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who has supported the association during this year. Whether it be through your membership and registration of animals, participating in or planning events, or just talking to your neighbor about White Park cattle. We are fortunate to have members who dedicate much of their time to make our shows and other events a success. On behalf of the entire association, thanks for your dedication.

I hope that everyone has a wonderful holiday season. This is always an enjoyable but busy time of the year. We often get to spend some time with friends and relatives that we don't see very often but at the same time, we have extra winter chores in addition to off the farm work commitments. However, I hope that we all take time out of our busy schedules to enjoy each day because they go by so quickly.
