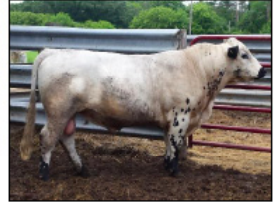

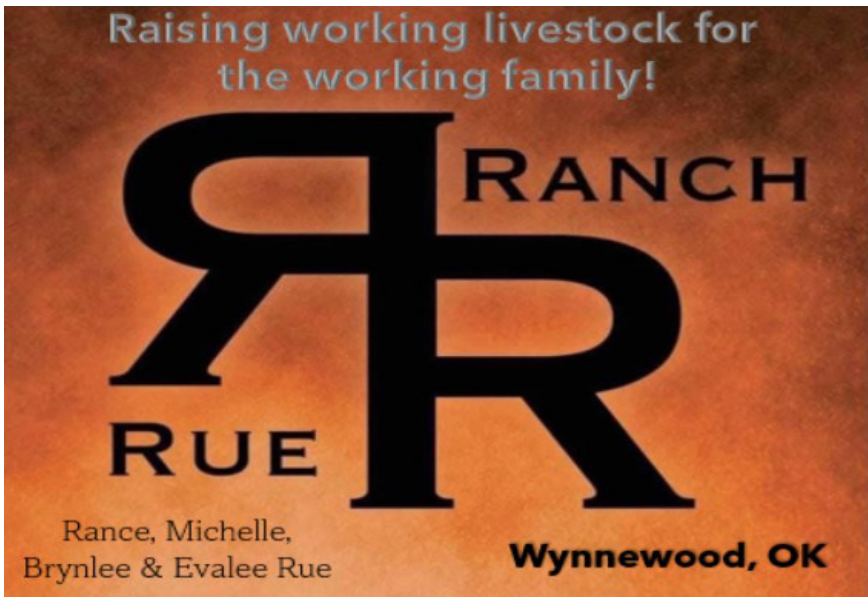

We recommend you ***never assume*** that any registration can be transferred. You should submit a copy of the BWCAA paper to this office prior to purchasing any animal if registering the animal in our association is important to you.

The same applies when you are purchasing semen from a bull registered in the BWCAA. Please confirm with our office before you purchase the semen that the offspring will be eligible for registration in our association.

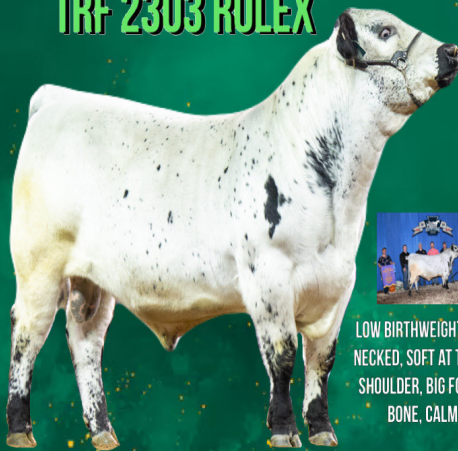

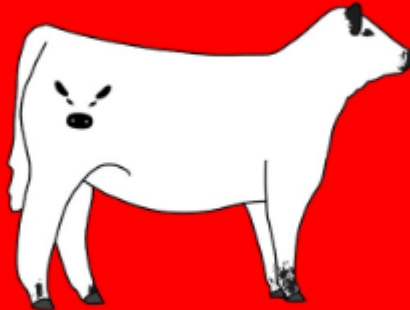

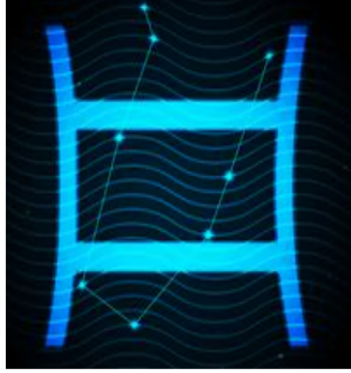
